Eligibility Requirements for Exam	<p>Applicants must meet all of the following requirements.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 He or she may not be in possession of Japanese citizenship and must have entered the country, or intend to enter the country for the purpose of education at a university. 2 He or she must have completed 12 years of enrolled education or the equivalent in a foreign country and meet the criteria declared by the Japanese Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (he/she must be of at least 18 years of age by March 31, 2012, including those who correspond to any of the following): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Those who have obtained an international baccalaureat certification granted by the International Baccalaureate Organization in accordance with the Civil Code of Switzerland (2) Those who have obtained certification equivalent to a baccalaureat certification permitting the holder to enter university as recognized by the French Republic (3) Those who have obtained a general certificate of eligibility to enter university of equivalence to an Abitur certificate permitting the holder to enter university as recognized by each state of the Federal Republic of Germany 3 He or she must have taken the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students during the first or second session in 2011. 4 He or she must have taken the TOEFL or TOEIC (public test) examination on or after April 1, 2010.
